Date Filed: 23 May 1851 -- Samuel Worline, Guardian of John Seigfried's Heirs to Philaster E. Buell -- Southern half of Lot 11 R19, Twp.4, Sec.4 U.S. Military Lands -- 50 acres in Liberty Twp. -- Selling Price: \$700. -- Samuel Worline became guardian and had sold the land at public auction 19 Aug. 1848 -- Levi Siegfried was named as an heir.

-- Tombstone is in German

-- buried next to husband in Northwood Division

7 Aug. 1852 -- Samuel Worline, guardian of John Seigfried's heirs, made settlement of his account as such guardian.

17 Dec. 1855 (Final Settlement) -- Samuel Worline guardian of Sarah and Nester Ann Seigfried

"Early Delaware County Burying Grounds"

"In 1851 an association was formed and Oak Grove Cemetery was opened. The old city burial ground was used to some extent until 1889. In March, 1901, the remains of all monuments and grave markers were removed to Oak Grove Cemetery. Where there were relatives still living, the burials were made on family lots. Those having no living family connections were removed and buried on a plot in the southwest part of the new cemetery." NOTE: John Siegfried, his wife, Eva, and mother, Catherine were buried in a family plot
